PRE-BRONZE LEVEL

Multi-Circle Waltz



This pattern is a figure 8 with each of the largest circles slightly flattened so the entire ring is used.

- 1 - Circle Right (8')
- 2 - Circle Right (8')
- 3 - Circle Right (12')
- 4 - Circle Left (8')
- 5 - Circle Left (8')
- 6 - Circle Left (12')

For entry, complete the 6 step pattern once.

Teams may work in Heel or Side position.

1, 2, 4, and 5 start at the 1/3 and 2/3 points of the largest circles (see sizes below in "NOTE").

3 and 6 take place inside the circle which the team just completed (see sizes below in "NOTE").

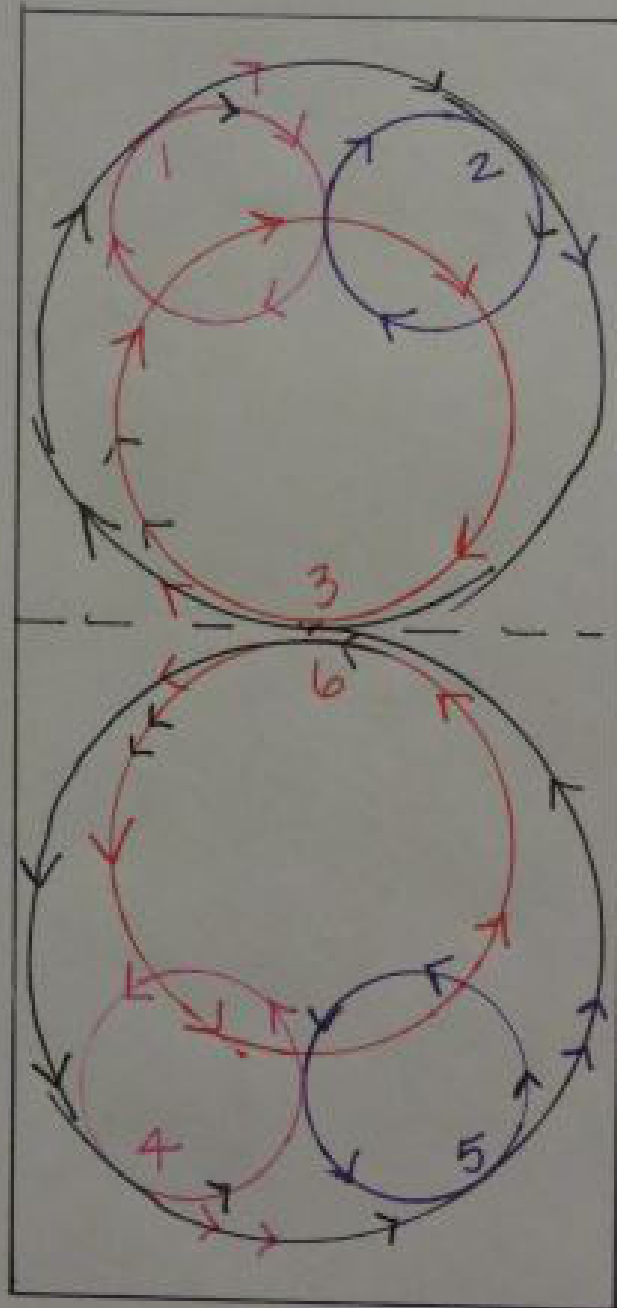
Give your dog time and space to change leads as you finish Stations 3 and 6 and move onto the next large circle.

NOTE: Stations 1, 2, 4, and 5, are each 8 feet in diameter, measured by the path of either Dog or Handler +/- 2 feet. They are actual circles and not 360s (neither dog nor handler should be pivoting at any time; keep walking forward on a curve). Stations 3 and 6 are each 12 feet in diameter, measured by the path of either Dog or Handler +/- 2 feet. Err on the side of bigger for your circles b/c too small will result in an NQ! The result is large enough contrasting circles to perform this pattern correctly.

Circles each start and finish in the same spot.

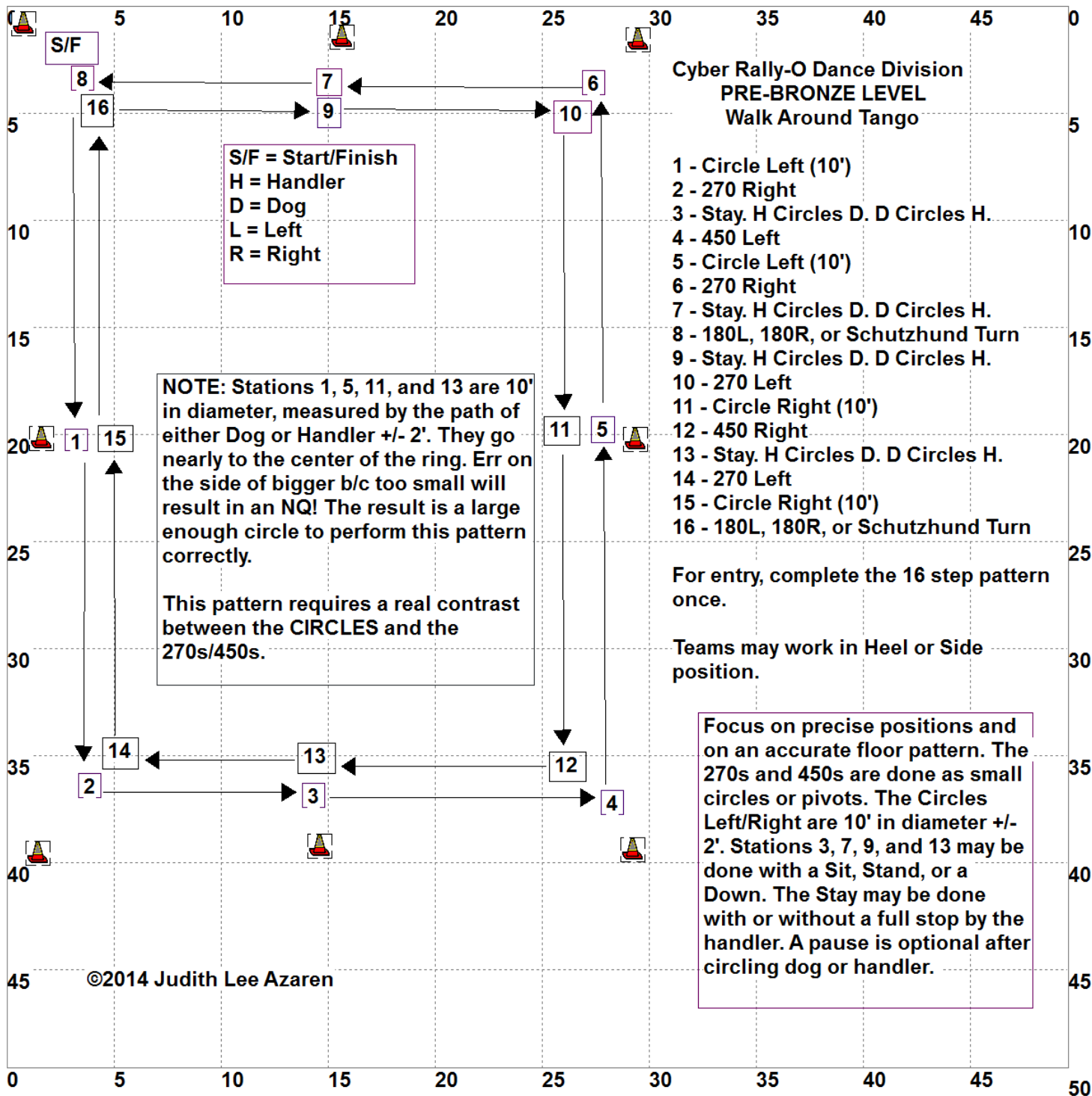

PRE-BRONZE LEVEL
Walk Around Tango**

- 1 - Circle Left (10')
- 2 - 270 Right
- 3 - Stay. H Circles D. D Circles H.
- 4 - 450 Left
- 5 - Circle Left (10')
- 6 - 270 Right
- 7 - Stay. H Circles D. D Circles H.
- 8 - 180L, 180R, or Schutzhund Turn
- 9 - Stay. H Circles D. D Circles H.
- 10 - 270 Left
- 11 - Circle Right (10')
- 12 - 450 Right
- 13 - Stay. H Circles D. D Circles H.
- 14 - 270 Left
- 15 - Circle Right (10')
- 16 - 180L, 180R, or Schutzhund Turn

NOTE: Stations 1, 5, 11, and 13 are 10' in diameter, measured by the path of either Dog or Handler +/- 2'. They go nearly to the center of the ring. Err on the side of bigger b/c too small will result in an NQ! The result is a large enough circle to perform this pattern correctly.

This pattern requires a real contrast between the CIRCLES and the 270s/450s.

For entry, complete the 16 step pattern once.

Teams may work in Heel or Side position.

Focus on precise positions and on an accurate floor pattern. The 270s and 450s are done as small circles or pivots. The Circles Left/Right are 10' in diameter +/- 2'. Stations 3, 7, 9, and 13 may be done with a Sit, Stand, or a Down. The Stay may be done with or without a full stop by the handler. A pause is optional after circling dog or handler.
